

Policies already in place to phase out fossil fuels


High demand for green hydrogen from renewable power


Green hydrogen: the Ultimate energy goal for Germany

African nations need to set-up policy, capacity, and infrastructure for H2




HYDROGEN ECONOMY IN WEST AFRICA
